

# Honeybourne Harriers Covid Protocol

## Pre Match Day

- Visiting Teams will receive an electronic copy of the Track and Trace form which must be completed and handed to the Honeybourne Harriers Covid Officer on match day.
- Visiting Managers and Secretaries will also be sent a copy of the Covid Protocol and requested to share it with Players and Parents prior to match day.
- Visiting Teams will be informed of the Covid waiting area they are to report 30 minutes before KO – if they arrive earlier than 30 minutes they will need to wait in their cars.
- Face Masks must be worn by anyone over the age of 11 as per the government guidelines while in the Covid waiting area and when they enter the pavilion.
- Matt Henson will be responsible for communicating the above to visiting teams

## Away Team Arrival

- Visiting Teams must arrive 30 mins prior to kick off and go to the designated Covid waiting box after sanitising their hands at the Hand sanitising station.
- If all players, spectators, coaches for the visiting team are not present 30 mins before the game then the Covid Officer will not perform the checks and the visiting team will need to wait until all parties are present before leaving the Covid waiting area.
- Completed track and trace form from the visiting team must be handed to the Honeybourne Harriers Covid Office so they can perform temperature checks.
- All players, spectators and coaches will have their temperature checked and anyone with a temperature of 37.8 (or higher) from that household will not be permitted to stay.

## General Covid Rules

- Hand Sanitiser must be used.
- Face Masks must be worn by all over the age of 11 when in the pavilion.
- Social Distancing guidance must be followed – 2 meters distance to be observed at all times
- One Way system must be followed at the ground and in the pavilion.
- It is the parent's role to enter the field of play (once the referee has given the ok) and administer first aid, in serious or life-threatening situations, the coach or first aider will be called on to the pitch.
